2018 Supplemental Benefit Changes



- Vision- 4% increase in rates.
- Whole Life Insurance, Critical Illness- Moving from Colonial to Unum.
- Medical Flexible Spending Accounts- Maximum increased to \$2,600.

Enrolling in Supplemental Benefits

1. To review plan options, go to MyWalkerBenefits.com and click the GREEN button.
2. To enroll, go to MyWalkerBenefits.com and click the BLUE button.
3. To access the enrollment system a username and password will be needed.

Username = Up to first 6 letters of last name, first letter of first name and last 4 numbers of SSN (Example-John Smith 111-22-3333;
Username is smithj3333)

Password = If you have never logged in, your temporary password will be your full SSN without dashes. For those that have logged in previously, use the Forgot Password link if needed.

Contact the Call Center with any login issues.

4. Once logged in, click on the Get Started button and follow prompts to update personal and dependent information.

To cover a spouse or child(ren), enter them as dependents.

5. Click Save & Continue after each benefit and add beneficiaries as needed.

If a benefit is elected that requires an Evidence of Insurability form, be sure to print, complete and mail the form directly to the insurance company.

6. Review elections and then click Finish Elections to complete the enrollment. Print or Email enrollment confirmation using icons on the right.

Important Notices

- Plan premiums may fluctuate due to changes in salary or age brackets.
- Flexible Spending Account participants MUST re-enroll for the upcoming plan year.
- If dependent is no longer a full-time student, please verify eligibility for coverage to reduce the possibility of unnecessary premiums.
- Employee is responsible for removing any dependents from coverage due to age limitations or divorce.
- Duplication of life coverage is not allowed for spouses or dependents who work with the same employer.
